On behalf of Ontario's four feather boards, the Feather Board Command Centre is announcing that the ILT Biosecurity Advisory Area, that was established on April 24, 2019 and updated May 5, 2019, in eastern Elgin County has now been lifted.

Under direction of the veterinarian and using FBCC protocols, all remaining infected birds have been depopulated and clean up completed.

Normal biosecurity levels in the area can now be restored.
