

Paramyxovirus (PPMV-1) BIOSECURITY ADVISORY Stand Down

Tottenham, Simcoe County

February 22, 2022

The Feather Board Command Centre is announcing a Stand Down for the Biosecurity Advisory issued February 3, 2022, for an area around Tottenham in Simcoe County.

The Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) has indicated that the backyard pigeon flock has been depopulated and the premises cleaned and disinfected. Normal prescribed biosecurity standards can now be restored throughout this area.

In addition, CFIA staff informed the FBCC that 2 other infected racing pigeon premises in Mississauga and Whitby have been satisfactorily resolved. Quarantines and movement controls have been lifted.

Thank you for your successful efforts to protect the health of your flocks and those of your clients and neighbours during this disease incident.
