On behalf of Ontario's four feather boards, the Feather Board Command Centre is announcing that the Infectious Laryngotracheitis (ILT) Biosecurity Advisory Area, that was established on April 24, 2020, in central Northumberland County has now been lifted.

All the birds in the small flock died or were humanely euthanized. Under veterinary direction, the premises has been cleaned and disinfected. New birds are being raised in a separate area.

No other cases in the area were reported.

Basic biosecurity levels in the area can now be restored.
